In my late 20's I transitioned from the world of large-scale sculpture fabrication to building design and construction and earned a Master of Architecture at Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute. In the building design and construction arena, I have moved through specialty and traditional commercial and residential project delivery, working on a diverse range of public and private projects ranging up to approximately \$15M and 100,000 square feet. Along the way, I have operated in the role of entrepreneur, establishing multiple independent small businesses which continue to operate successfully today.
